

Call to order:

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M. in the Peter Christensen Health Care Center meeting room by Chairman Al Bauman, with the following committee present: Jack Harrison, Maynard Bedish, Gene Ciszek and Sig Hjemvick. Eric Chapman and Elmer Rising Sun were absent. Others present or addressing the committee during this meeting: Vilas County Juvenile Intake Supervisor Robert Rickard, Lac du Flambeau Town Supervisor Mike Christensen, Lac du Flambeau Police Chief Bob Brandenburg and Vilas County Sheriff Frank Tomlanovich. Open meeting notices and quorum present were verified by the Chair.

Approve agenda to be discussed in any order by the Chair:

Motion by J. Harrison, 2nd by M. Bedish to approve the agenda with the order of discussion at the Chair's discretion. All voted aye. Carried.

Approve March 24, 2011 meeting minutes:

Motion by S. Hjemvick, 2nd by M. Bedish to approve the minutes of the March 24, 2011 meeting as presented. All voted aye. Carried.

Juvenile Intensive Supervision Program update:

Robert Rickard presented to the committee a written report which was to be publicized as of February 23, 2011. It describes the Intensive Supervision and the Juvenile. The program was implemented in Vilas County approximately 9 years ago by Judge James Mohr; the purpose was to try to keep juveniles in the community rather than sending them to placement outside of the community. It gives the juvenile a blueprint of what is expected while on the program. It was noted that in Vilas County, approximately 80 juveniles have been on the program since its inception and has helped juveniles remain in their home and community.

Law Enforcement update:

a. Meeting update:

It was noted by Chief B. Brandenburg that the meetings between the Vilas County Sheriff Department and the Lac du Flambeau Police Department have been communicating very well.

b. Arrest and activity schedule:

There was no arrest and activity schedule presented to the committee.

c. Drug enforcement:

B. Brandenburg stated he had been communicating with people responsible for dispensing pain pills were dispensing to great a quantity at a time. He also noted there is still a big problem with the drug situation. There was a discussion on parents allowing their kids to have alcohol at parties in their homes and in some incidences, furnishing it.

County Highway D – downtown Lac du Flambeau:

M. Christensen and A. Bauman each explained the problem with the turn and parking area around the new police station and library which turned into a long discussion. The committee came up with 3 different options which were discussed and the cost problem

also came into the picture. S. Hjemvick suggested the problem be sent to the county safety committee which all agreed for further review.

Health / Community Health update:

Nothing presented.

Tribal Compact funds:

Animal control issues:

A. Bauman said there is a big problem with the animal issue in Vilas County because of lack of space at the animal shelter. He said they were looking at a possible agreement with the Iron River animal shelter which was noted to be quite a distance away.

The Chair asked that he be given any new agenda items at least 10 days before the next meeting.
