Child Support Matters – The Committee reviewed the April Expenditure Guidelines. Ms. Benson attended a meeting on May 14 & 15 regarding AARA Funding. The main topic was stimulus money and how it should be spend. Ms. Benson should receive the final approval for this money by July 1. Another idea for this money is to subscribe to Clear Program. This program is for government agencies and is connected with statewide court proceedings and credit bureaus. The fee is \$28 per month per user. The Child Support office attended the security training presented by the IT Dept. Ms. Gromoll will be attending the training this Friday. Motion by Gene Ciszek, seconded by Sig Hjemvick to approve the bills for the Child Support Office. All voting aye. Carried.

Veteran=s Service Office Matters –The Committee reviewed the April Expenditure Guideline prepared by the County Clerk and the May guideline prepared by Mr. Jensen. The Committee discussed a recognition award for Don Parker. The Committee asked that Mr. Jensen prepare a resolution and certificate of appreciation for the next meeting. The Committee discussed the Memorial Day program. Mr. Jensen thanked Eric Johnson, reporter from the Lakeland Times, for the wonderful coverage of the Memorial Day program. Mr. Jensen received a news release regarding Agent Orange and more diseases are open for service-connected disabilities. The\$10,000 VSO Grant was submitted, but as of today, the check has not been received. Motion by Gene Ciszek, seconded by Sig Hjemvick to approve the following out of county travel: for Scott Jensen – NECVSO meeting in Antigo, June 24 with a cost of approximately \$85.00 and for Debbie Durski – NECVSO support staff training in King, July 22 with a cost of approximately \$180.00. Motion by Steve Favorite, seconded by Gene Ciszek to approve Ms. Milanowski attending collective bargaining and binging arbitration seminar in Pewaukee, July 20. All voting aye. Carried. Motion by Steve Favorite, seconded by Gene Ciszek to approve the bills for the Corporation Counsel Office. All

voting aye. Carried. Ms. Milanowski suggested talking about the Child Support legal matters at the next meeting.
