**Approve minutes:** Motion by P. Norris, seconded by J. Sherwood, to approve the April 29, 2014 meeting minutes. All voting aye, carried.

**Closed session:** Motion by J. Sherwood, seconded by D. Meyer, to convene into closed session, pursuant to Wis. **Committee may take action on matters discussed in closed session:** Motion by J. Sherwood, seconded by P. Norris to authorize the hiring of T. Budde for part-time deputy – boat patrol assignment. All voting aye, carried.

**Correction Officer Eligibility List – set meeting date to review applications:** Meeting will be held on July 18, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. (other items to be included on agenda: deputy eligibility list and snowmobile patrol position)

**Letters and Communications:** Sheriff Fath explained that the Snowmobile Safety Committee Safety Committee is considering changing the title and duties of their Committee to encompass all trails in Vilas County and has asked the Sheriff to consider the possibility of assigning a deputy to recreational trail patrol. Chair Obermann indicated that the terms of J. Sherwood and D. Preuss are coming to an end this Fall and will need to be addressed by the County Board Chair. Ms. Preuss has submitted her resignation from the Commission effective on today's date for personal reasons.
