

Harvest Regulations:

1. **Aspen Clearcut:** Harvest all merchantable trees except oak, birch, red pine and white pine. All non-merchantable trees having a diameter 1" and greater must be cut. Harvest boundary is Gravel Pit Road or marked with red paint. Do not harvest trees marked with red paint. Do not operate outside of red paint lines, around Utility Tower or within Green Tree Retention Buffer. Do not drop trees over red paint line.
2. Avoid damage to residual trees. This reduces the risk of spreading disease and degrading future crop trees. Excessive rutting and/or excessive damage to residual trees will cause temporary closure of harvesting operations. Do not damage relic fire scar stumps/trees. Leave all dead snags standing.
3. Tree and pole length skidding will be allowed if the contractor demonstrates the ability to skid without damaging residual trees. If excessive damages occurs penalties will apply and skidding will be limited to shortwood skidding.
4. Existing trails serve this area sufficiently; therefore, Vilas County prohibits the construction of new roads. All roads and landings must be cleared and leveled upon sale completion.
5. A state funded snowmobile trail uses Birchwood Drive and Gravel Pit Road. During the snow season, the contractor must keep snowmobile trails free of logging debris and equipment. When plowing during this time the contractor must leave snow on the trail at all times.
6. Stump height not to exceed 6".
7. No decking along Birchwood Drive or Gravel Pit Road.
8. No harvesting during the oak wilt no-cut period from April 15th-July 15th.
9. Refer to the Timber Sale Contract for all harvest regulations.
