

Harvest Regulations:

1. **Oak Shelterwood:** Harvest all trees with a diameter of 1" and greater except Yellow Birch, Hemlock, and all trees marked with purple paint. Leave all dead trees standing unless they create a hazard during forest operations.
2. **Oak Thinning:** Harvest all trees marked with orange paint and all merchantable balsam fir having at least one pulp stick. Leave all dead trees standing unless they create a hazard during forest operations.
3. No harvesting during the Oak Wilt no-cut period from April 15th-July 15th.
4. During the period from May 15 through August 15, the contractor must remove all cut pine products from the sale area within 14 days of cutting.
5. Avoid damage to residual trees including advance regeneration. This reduces the risk of spreading disease and degrading future crop trees. Excessive rutting and/or excessive damage to residual trees will cause temporary closure of harvesting operations. Do not damage relic fire scar stumps/trees.
6. Shortwood skidding is required to minimize damage to advance regeneration.
7. Existing trails serve this area sufficiently; therefore, Vilas County prohibits the construction of new roads. All roads and landings must be cleared and leveled upon sale completion. Hunter Hiking Trails must be left in an equal or better condition that is conducive for mowing post-harvest.
8. No decking along Baker Lake Rd.
9. All trees felled across the Blue Paint Lines must be pulled back into the sale area before being limbed and topped.
10. Refer to the Timber Sale Contract for all harvest regulations.
