

**Harvest Regulations:**

1. **Shelterwood Area:** Harvest all trees that are not marked with purple paint. All non-merchantable trees having a diameter 1" and greater must be cut concurrent with the harvest of merchantable wood. Harvest boundary marked with red paint.
2. **Pine Thinning Area:** Harvest all trees marked with orange paint. Do Not Cut any unmarked Red Pine or White Pine. Leave dead trees standing unless they create a hazard during forest operations. Do not enter aspen sapling areas.
3. Avoid damage to residual trees including advanced regeneration. This reduces the risk of spreading disease and degrading future crop trees. Excessive rutting and/or excessive damage to residual trees will cause temporary closure of harvesting operations. Do not damage relic fire scar stumps/trees.
4. During the period from May 15 through August 15, the contractor must remove all cut pine products from the sale area within 14 days of cutting.
5. No harvesting from April 1st through August 1st.
6. Shortwood skidding is required. Tree and pole length skidding will not be permitted.
7. Many of the existing trails are grown over and will need to be re-opened or re-routed. Work with Vilas County Forestry staff on any trail re-routes. All roads and landings must be cleared and leveled upon sale completion.
8. All trees felled across the Blue Paint Lines must be pulled back into the sale area before being limbed and topped.
9. Refer to the Timber Sale Contract for all harvest regulations.
