

**Harvest Regulations:**

1. Harvest all red pine within the sale area and all white pine marked with orange paint.  
 Do Not Cut any oak or unmarked white pine.  
 Leave all dead trees standing unless they create a hazard during forest operations. Do not cut any other trees.
2. Harvesting is restricted to the period of August 1 to March 31 following.
3. Damage to established regeneration and/or residual trees must be avoided to reduce the risk of spreading disease and degrading the stand. Excessive rutting and/or Excessive damage to established regeneration/residual trees will cause temporary closure of harvesting operations.
4. Shortwood skidding is required. Skid trails must utilize the shortest and most direct route to the nearest access/woods road. All trees must be directionally felled into and limbed within the skid trails.
5. This area is sufficiently served by existing trails, therefore no new roads will be allowed to be constructed. All roads and landings must be cleared and leveled upon sale completion.
6. Access along the west boundary of the sale uses a state funded snowmobile trail. During the snow season the snowmobile trails must be kept free of logging debris and equipment. Plowing during this time must be done so as to leave snow cover on the trail at all times.
7. All trees felled across the Blue Paint Lines must be pulled back into the sale area before being limbed and topped.
