- * To sign a cost-share contract agreement with the Vilas County. Participating landowners are responsible for payment of all project costs up front. The 50, 60, or 70% cost share amount is reimbursed to the landowner after verification that eligible expenses were incurred and that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the restoration plan.
- * Plants, materials, and labor to implement the plan are eligible expenses up to the maximum listed on the cost-share agreement. Professional project installation can be reimbursed from an itemized invoice. Maintenance expenses, including expenses for watering the site after planting, are not eligible for reimbursement. Costs incurred before the cost share agreement is signed are not eligible for reimbursement.
- * There are fees charged to participate in this program. There is a flat fee of \$25 to apply for the program and additional \$40 flat fee to cover the cost of 1 hour of technical services. After that technical services are provided by Vilas County Conservation staff for a fee of \$40/hour; accruing at 1/2 hour intervals.
- * There are provisions for program fee and reimbursement rate adjustments, if the county determines that the landowner qualifies for economic hardship status. Please enquire for details.
